



Provision of Education and Training for Learners who are Self-Isolating, Furloughed, working from home.

For Learners who have been advised to self-isolate, but are well enough to learn, Sporting Futures Training will continue with their delivery of training and education remotely as far as is reasonably possible.

In circumstances where Learners need to undertake their learning remotely, they will benefit from the same amount of teaching and guided work that they would normally receive on-site.

There will be times when onsite observations will not be possible, however, the SFT Tutors will use their best endeavours to deliver as much of students' planned hours as possible.

There may also be times when we need to consider remote End Point Assessments – Tutors will support Learners in all eventualities with regards to ensuring that learners are in no way disadvantaged through the current pandemic.

At SFT we endeavour to:

- adapt and sequence education and training programmes to continue to give our Learners the best chance to build their knowledge and skills throughout this challenging time.
- provide our Learners with individual assessment and feedback to support progress in their learning at least fortnightly whilst undertaking their Apprenticeship.
- SFT have systems in place to check, at least weekly, for persistent non-attendance or lack of engagement with remote education and to quickly agree ways with the learner, tutor and mentor ways in which attendance and participation can be improved.
- SFT will continue to give particular consideration on how best to support vulnerable and disadvantaged Learners and Learners with additional needs.
